



TEA MENU

Black Teas

Milawa Breakfast \$6.0 pot
Blend of premium teas from India, Sri Lanka and Kenya. This tea has notes of honey and malt and is delicious served black but also strong enough to pair with milk. Ingredients: Black Tea

English Breakfast \$5.0 pot
A traditional full-bodied English Breakfast tea.
Ingredients: Black Tea

Earl Grey \$5.0 pot
Strong, floral tea, rich with bergamot.
Ingredients: Black tea, natural bergamot oil, organic corn flowers

Black Beauty (rare) \$7.5 pot
This organic black tea was produced by small farmers in Boseong, Korea. It has flavour notes of honey, malt and almonds and is best enjoyed without milk. Ingredients: Black Tea

Doke Black Fusion (rare) \$7.5 pot
An award-winning hand-rolled black tea from the Bihar region of India. The steeped leaf produces a coppery infusion with aromas of cocoa and date and a sweet taste with slightly dry finish. Ingredients: Black Tea

Golden Monkey (rare) \$7.5 pot
A legendary Chinese tea, one of the finest teas of Fujian Province. A smooth tippy tea, low in tannin but rich in flavour. Ingredients: Black Tea

Australian Daintree (rare) \$7.5 pot
Grown in Cubbagudta, in the heart of the Daintree wilderness. It has a medium strength and is a delicate tea of fine quality, with little or no astringency in the flavour. Good to drink with milk. Ingredients: Black Tea

Ancient Red Dragon (rare) \$7.5 pot
A unique handmade tea processed from high grown, young leaves from the ancient tea trees of Vietnam. It has golden tips, enhancing the sweetness and creating a bright, copper-coloured infusion. The tea is slightly sweet and malty with hints of cacao and is best enjoyed without milk. Ingredients: Black Tea

Black Teas

Black Pearls (rare)

\$7.5 pot

This award winning black tea, has been carefully handcrafted and rolled into tea pearls by small farmers at the Kaley Tea Estate in Sri Lanka. The leaves unfurl to produce a golden liquor with delicate floral and fruity notes. Ingredients: Black Tea

Rwandan CTC (rare)

\$7.5 pot

Grown at an elevation of approximately 2000 meters in the northern part of the country. The infusion is robust with a medium astringency that has notes of earthy, hint of toasty and mineral along with a honey like sweetness aftertaste. CTC is referred to as the grading of the tea being "Crush, Tear, Curl". Ingredients: Black Tea

Smoky Ecstasy (rare)

\$7.5 pot

A delight for those who enjoy their tea with a twist. Smoky Ecstasy is earthy, robust, and energising, with a hint of smokiness. Ingredients: Black Tea

Christmas Carol

\$7.5 pot

A special black tea inspired by the traditional Christmas pudding and blended with berries, citrus and spice for a special annual occasion. Ingredients: Black Tea, Orange Peel, Elderberry, Cinnamon, Clove

Earl Grey with A Twist

\$6.0 pot

Carefully selected black teas from Sri Lanka blended them with natural pure bergamot extract, orange and lemon peels, and a touch of blue cornflowers. Ingredients: Black Tea, Bergamot, Cornflowers, Orange Peel, Lemon Peel

Royal Delight

\$6.0 pot

This Sri Lankan black tea is both beautiful to look at and to taste. It combines quality black tea with floral and fruit notes. Ingredients: Black Tea, Rose Petals, Blue Mallow Flower, Calendula, Natural Flavours

French Earl Grey

\$6.0 pot

A romantic, rosy aroma and a delicious light tangy lemon flavour. Ingredients: Black Tea, Bergamot, Hibiscus, Rose Petals, Calendula, Blue Cornflower

Queen's Choice

\$6.0 pot

This gorgeous, festive black and oolong tea blend contains cornflowers and safflowers blended with delicious berry flavours. Enjoy every sip with a sweet taste that lingers. Ingredients: Black Tea, Oolong Tea, Calendula, Cornflower, Safflower, Natural Blackberry, Natural Strawberry

Black Blends

Green Teas

Anji Bai Cha (rare) \$8.50 pot
Very rich in amino acids, this tea is from Anji county, Zhe Jiang province, China. To create the tea, two young leaves are plucked for every leaf shoot contained in the batch. It is what gives it its more mature, robust flavour. Its liquor is pale. Ingredients: Green Tea

Organic Woojeon (rare) \$8.50 pot
Woojeon is one of the most famed teas of Korea. The leaves are taken from the tea bush before the tropical monsoon season begins. Woojeon is a real treat for anyone looking to expand their tasting horizons to Korea, a beautiful tea impossible not to appreciate. Ingredients: Green Tea

Arakai Spring Flush Green (rare) \$8.50 pot
An award-winning Australian-grown green tea from Bellthorpe, Queensland. It comes from the first harvest in Spring after a Winter dormancy and has a buttery, floral aroma and pale gold liquor with a long, lingering sweetness in the mouth. Ingredients: Green Tea

Ankang Selenium Green (rare) \$8.50 pot
From the Ankang Province in China, this tea is naturally high in a mineral called selenium which is known to be beneficial for the immune system. The selenium occurs naturally in the soil and is absorbed by the plants. This tea is naturally sweet. Ingredients: Green Tea

Jasmine Pearls (rare) \$8.50 pot
Uses a traditional Chinese tea-scenting technique that dates back over 1,000 years. Made with tender spring-harvested green tea buds, hand-rolled and deeply infused with jasmine. Jasmine blossoms are layered amongst the tea leaves to impart their delicate fragrance. Ingredients: Green Tea, Jasmine Flowers

Moroccan Mint \$6.50 pot
A traditional Moroccan infusion of green tea blended with peppermint and spearmint. Ingredients: Green Tea, Peppermint, Spearmint

Green Tea + Peach \$6.50 pot
A quality high grade Sencha tea, naturally flavoured with peaches and apricots. Ingredients: Green Tea, Apricot, Safflower, Natural Flavour

Turkish Delight \$6.50 pot
A delightfully smooth blend of Himalayan Green Tea and Australian cacao shells with a hint of floral Rose Petals.
Ingredients: Green Tea, Cacao Shells, Rose Petals

Longjing (rare) \$8.50 pot
The most famous green tea in China. with a distinct shape achieved by highly skilled shaping in a hot wok. The tea is mostly handmade and gives an inviting, vegetal and toasty aroma

Green Teas

Australian Sunrise \$6.50 pot
Australian Sunrise is an invigorating, delicious blend of Australian green tea, fragrant Strawberry Gum, zesty Desert Finger Lime, and soothing calendula with peachy notes of Australian quandong extract. Perfect to drink at sunrise or at any time of the day. Ingredients: Green Tea, Strawberry Gum, Finger lime, Calendula, Quandong Extract

Mojito \$6.50 pot
A classic summer mocktail, inspired by the real thing but without the hangover. Green tea blended with mint, a hint of citrus and natural flavouring. Delicious iced, served with sprigs of mint and slices of lemon and lime; equally as delicious served warm. Ingredients: Green Tea, Peppermint, Spearmint, Lime Peel, Lemon Peel, Natural flavour

Gunpowder \$6.50 pot
Chinese Gunpowder is a Green Tea which is tightly rolled to form a pellet. When brewed, it will present pale green in colour and smooth in flavour, with a distinctive dryness that is associated with green gunpowder teas. Ingredients: Green Tea

Choc Mint \$6.50 pot
An organic Japanese Hojicha blended with organic peppermint leaves. The peppermint takes the chocolate notes from the roasted tea, while also acting as a relaxant. This is a lovely relaxing and warming tea, low in caffeine. Ingredients: Hojicha, Peppermint

Yellow Teas

Huo Shan Yellow Bud (rare) \$9.0 pot
An imperial tribute tea that has been made in China since the Ming Dynasty. Like with many yellow teas, the processing method was lost – however it was recovered during 1972. The yellow colour is produced by spreading the tea indoors in three separate rounds. Do not oversteep. Ingredients: Yellow Tea

Dark Teas

Royal (Shou) Puerh (rare) \$9.0 pot
Royal Puerh is a ripe Puerh. It is produced like a green tea. The resulting beverage is described as having little to no astringency and mellow, smooth, 'peaty', and subtly sweet flavours with a nice thick mouth feel. Ingredients: Puerh Tea

Sheng Puerh (rare) \$9.0 pot
Sheng is a Puerh tea which is produced like a green tea. When properly steeped it is a wonderfully aromatic astringent, sometimes bitter and a complex beverage. The flavours are a combination of 'grassy' or fresh hay characteristics, floral notes and sometimes having hints of dried fruit. Ingredients: Puerh Tea

White Teas

Indonesian Silver Needle (rare) \$8.50 pot
From the Bankitwangi estate in West Java, this tea is gathered only for a few days in early spring, and is carefully hand picked and dried. This tea is certified organic and is produced at an estate surrounded by rainforest from the Sinensis cultivar of *Camellia sinensis*. The pale, ivory coloured liquor has a lingering fragrance of honeysuckle and almond blossom and a gentle flavour of ripe peach. Ingredients: White tea

Snow Dragon (rare) \$8.50 pot
This rare white tea is produced from the ancient tea trees in the north of Vietnam. A unique white tea with a curly, downy leaf and delicate aromas of stone fruit. Ingredients: White Tea

Camellia Bud (rare) \$8.50 pot
A delicate tea from China made from the flower buds of the tea plant *Camellia Sinensis*. The liquor is pale and fragrant with a clean, refreshing finish. Ingredients: White tea

Silver Rings (rare) \$8.50 pot
A delicate artisan tea hand-made from downy tea buds by artisan tea farmers in Sri Lanka. The steeped liquor has a pale lemon hue and a soft fruity aroma. Ingredients: White Tea

White Champagne (rare) \$8.50 pot
This Sri Lankan white tea has been handmade from the buds and young leaves of tea bushes. It has a fruity flavour with notes of peach and a slightly dry finish. Ingredients: White Tea

Lychee Rose + Vanilla \$6.60 pot
This fruity infusion of white tea and rose is enhanced with soft, sweet, floral flavour of lychee and the warmth of vanilla bean. Ingredients: White Tea, Rose Petals, Natural Flavours

Mango White \$6.50 pot
A light, fruity infusion of white tea balanced with tropical mango flavours. Delicious iced in summer but can also be served warm. Ingredients: White tea, Mango Pieces, White Cornflower, Natural Flavours

Tequila Sunrise \$6.50 pot
A delicious mocktail blend of white tea, cranberry, hibiscus and orange pieces, enhanced by natural flavours. Ingredients: White Tea, Hibiscus, Cranberry Pieces, Orange peel, natural orange, natural pomegranate

Oolong Teas

Oriental Beauty (rare)

\$8.5 pot

One of the most famous Oolongs in the world. It is a high-mountain, heavily fermented tea from Taiwan prized for its rich flavours and history. It is sometimes known as White Tip Oolong or Champagne Oolong. It's flavour depends heavily on careful and extensive processing. This tea is fermented at approximately 60%. You will note a floral aroma, amber brown liquor with a taste of ripe fruits and honey. Smooth and Mellow. Ingredients: Oolong Tea

Tie Guan Yin (rare)

\$8.5 pot

A premium Chinese Oolong. This tea is one of the only known teas that requires its own *C. sinensis* cultivar, and may be processed using only the proper tieguanyin processing techniques. It was named after Guanyin, the Chinese goddess of mercy. You will note the aroma of Orchids. The flavour is long lasting, with the liquor being golden in colour. The brewed tea will have a sweet Orchid flower aroma with a hint of Chestnut. Ingredients: Oolong Tea

Shui Jin Gui (rare)

\$8.5 pot

One of the famed Wuyi Rock teas, this tea can only be made from the leaves of a single tea bush on Wuyi Rock. When steeped, this tea produces a beautiful shade of bright green not seen in other Wuyi oolongs. The dry leaf is a golden black colour, leading to its name, Golden Marine Turtle. Ingredients: Oolong Tea

Citrus Oolong

\$6.5 pot

A blend of fruity roasted oolong with citrus pieces and a hint of flavour. Ingredients: Oolong Tea, Orange Peel, Lemon Peel, Calendula, Safflower, Natural Flavour

Tropical Oolong

\$6.5 pot

A fruity blend of oolong, Papaya, Pineapple, Hibiscus, Orange and lemon for health and vitality. Ingredients: Oolong Tea, Hibiscus, Papaya, Pineapple, Orange Peel, Lemon Peel, Natural Flavours

Hairy Crab (rare)

\$8.5 pot

A type of Anxi oolong tea that grows in many places in Anxi county of Fujian. Mao Xie means literally "Hair of the Crab" and refers to the hairs on the tea leaves that break off when brewed and float on the top of your cup. Mao Xie has got a thicker and sweeter taste than its more floral counterpart 'Tie Guan Yin'.

Herbal Tisanes

All decaffeinated

Pina Colada \$6.5 pot
A delicious, fruit punch blend of tropical fruits, coconut and rooibos inspired by a Pina Colada cocktail. Caffeine free. Ingredients: Mango, Papaya, Rooibos, Coconut Flakes, Apple Pieces, Hibiscus, Natural Flavours

Detox \$6.5 pot
Detox is a blend of cleansing herbs such as burdock, dandelion, St Marys Thistle, red clover flower and rhubarb root, with nutrient-rich nettle leaf, lemon verbena & liquorice root to aid digestion and clarifying lemon peel. Calendula may also help to calm the body while you detox. Ingredients: nettle, red clover, burdock root, dandelion root roasted, calendula, St Marys thistle, lemon verbena, liquorice root, rhubarb root, lemon peel

Wellbeing \$6.5 pot
A refreshing rooibos blend of mango, citrus, and chai spice. Delicious served hot or iced. Ingredients: Rooibos, mango, orange peel, lemon peel, cinnamon, ginger, cardamom and black peppercorns

Lime + Mints \$6.5 pot
Zesty peppermint and lime peel are balanced with sweet spearmint for an invigorating but soothing twist on an old favourite Ingredients: Peppermint, Spearmint, Lime Peel

Peppermint \$5.0 pot
A strong, traditional peppermint tea. Ingredients: Peppermint

Lemon Lift \$6.5 pot

Ingredients: Green Tea, Cinnamon, Cardamom, Star Anise, Orange Peel, Ginger

Bangalore Rose \$6.5 pot
-can be served as a brewed chai or a tea
This beautiful blend inspires luxury as light floral notes mingle with masala spices. Ingredients: Black Tea, Rose Petals, Ginger, Cardamom, Coriander, Cinnamon, Cloves, Black Peppercorns

Sticky Chai (not australia tea masters) \$5.0 pot
-Can be served as a brewed chai or a tea
A Sri Lankan favourite, this premium blend balances sweet lemongrass with gingery spice, creating a vibrant & revitalising brew. Ingredients: Lemongrass, ginger root

Purple Teas

Kenyan Purple Tea (rare) \$9.0 pot
Naturally occurring anthocyanin which may also be useful for cardiovascular health, blood sugar metabolism, and cholesterol levels, as well as containing natural antioxidants. This tea has a naturally sweet flavour, light vegetal notes with a refreshing finish. Ingredients: Purple Tea
